INTAKE AND ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Intake: 1. January, 2. May, 3. September

Entry Requirements:

- i. To obtain a Certificate in Education of Malaysia (SPM) * with at least 3 honors; or
- ii. Obtain a Unified Examination Certificate (UEC) with at least a Grade B in 3 subjects; or
- iii. Passing O-Level with at least credit in three subjects; or
- iv. Passed SKM Level 3 (Level 3, MOH) in a related field; and
 - Passed SPM with at least a credit in one subject; and
 - Through consolidation program (in case necessary); or
- v. Graduated Community College Certificate (Level 3, KKM) equivalent in a related field; and
 - Passed SPM with at least a credit in one subject; and
 - Through consolidation program (in case necessary); or
- vi. Pass Certificate (Level 3, MOH) in a related field with a minimum CGPA of 2.00; or
- vii. Pass a Malaysian High School Certificate (STPM) or equivalent with at least a Grade C (NGMP 2.00) in 1 subject; or
- viii. Pass the Malaysian Higher Education Certificate (STPM) with at least a Maqbool Grade; or
- ix. Any other qualifications that are recognized by the Malaysian Government.
