### Entry Requirements:

a) Obtained Malaysian University English Test (MUET) Band 3 or

International English Language Testing System (IEL TS) 5.5 / Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL) (550);

AND

a) Pass Matriculation/ Pre-University/ Higher School Certificate Malaysia (STPM) programme or equivalent qualification with minimum Grade Point Average (GPA) 2.33 in two of the following subjects:

- Biology
- Physics/Mathematics
- Chemistry

OR



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b) A - Level programme or equivalent qualification with minimum Grade D in two of the following subjects:

- Biology
- Physics/Mathematics
- Chemistry

OR

c) Recognised Diploma with minimum CGPA 2.75 in related field;

OR

d) Recognised Diploma with CGPA less than 2.75 in related field and a minimum of three years (36 months) working experience in the related field.

Candidate should obtain IELTS (5.5) /TOEFL (550) paper- based or equivalent.
